## The Spiritual Armor

Meditate on Ephesians 6:10-20

- For full armor to withstand any schemes of the adversary
- In thanksgiving, for the power of your salvation to helmet your past, present and future
- That your core commitment will be truth, a belt of reliability for all your relationships
- For every team member to have invincible integrity, a breastplate against accusations
- That you will not be so wrapped up in following your program for today, that you are unprepared to share the Good News of peace
- For faith in God to shield you against all evil attacks
- To advance with the penetrating, discerning truth of God's Word
- That each team member will experience, as never before, a greater personal resolve, standing for God in the strength of God
- For each team member to be on 24/7 prayer alert

#### Cornelius

#### Meditate on Acts 10

### Pray:

- His Holy Spirit would speak to the true seekers through dreams and visions
- He would lead you to identify God-fearers, leaders in the home and community who can influence entire families and communities for Him
- That God would verify the truth of His Son and the power of His resurrection through signs and wonders
- God would prepare the hearts and minds of all team members to share His truth in culturally sensitive and biblically appropriate ways
- The Lord will pour out His Spirit on the area where you pray and raise the level of awareness of God while you are there
- Each team member will be in a constant state of spiritual readiness when the call comes to share the truth
- The Holy Spirit will empower His message with His presence

## Spiritual Warfare

#### Meditate on 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

## Ask God that you would:

- Clearly see that your struggle is in no way against other people
- Claim His authority when confronted with the spiritual powers ruling over the area you are prayer walking
- Make every thought you have today obedient to Christ's guiding
- Shed light on the darkness of world forces, so lies and half-truths will be exposed for what they are
- Have a broken heart for the community where you prayer walk
- Resist personal attacks
- Know that the weapons of your warfare are not of human ingenuity, manipulations or psychological games —
   they are not of the flesh
- Know that there are fortresses that need demolition, and ask that He would make you strong enough to destroy the ungodly

## **Praise and Worship**

## Meditate on Deuteronomy 6:4-5

## Pray:

- Your love of God will grow to fill all of your heart as you worship Him
- The Holy Spirit will fill believers with boldness to pray for each other
- All team members will be sensitive to the hurts and needs of people for whom they have the opportunity to pray
- Team members will refine their skills of communicating the truth in love
- God will deliver team members from dangers they do not know exist

Favor, Wisdom, Knowledge

Meditate on Daniel 1:8-21

- The Lord to bless each member of the local government, so that they will use their position and authority to bless and not oppress
- the people under their jurisdiction
- That community leaders will commend the Gospel, not obstruct it
- That as you live through these intense days, your love will be incorruptible

#### Man of Peace

Meditate on Luke 10:1-11

## As you go out today, ask:

- That God will reveal to the people you pray for a need so great that their old answers and philosophies will no longer work
- For God to deepen their understanding and desire for Him
- God to strengthen your initial contacts with persons of peace
- For the Lord to stir up an interest and hunger for Himself in people's hearts
- That people who are potential leaders in new churches will respond to God's call
- For the sense of God's direction for this area to grow in the hearts of new believers
- That these new believers will have His desire to reach the nations with His truth

## Growing the Fellowship

## Meditate on 2 Timothy 2:2

## Pray:

- Hearts will be prepared to hear and respond to the Word
- God will ready a church to respond to the needs of new believers
- God will put Christians into their lives who will be faithful to the Great Commission task of discipling
- Conversions will mature into solid obedience
- God will prepare groups to minister to and instruct one another and to care for new believers
- These groups will begin praying for opportunities to share what they have learned with others

## Supplication

Meditate on Psalm 96:3

Pray that today these will be your words to

## God:

- "Bring me to the point where I am completely conformed to Your will, to the point where I love You more than anything."
- "Teach me to go where You want me to go."
- "Show me how to be who You want me to be."
- "I make myself available today to reflect Your glory, through my actions, attitudes, thoughts, desires, words."

#### Intercession for the Workers

#### Meditate on 2 Corinthians 1:3-11

- God to encourage and sustain His workers in this area through the prayers of many and that many more would be called to join them in prayer
- God to comfort His workers who are enduring affliction just as He comforted His Son on the cross
- That pray-ers would be aware that many workers are burdened beyond their strength, some to the point of death
- For workers to have the grace to trust not in themselves but in God who loves and cares for them completely
- God to assure His workers of deliverance
- That His workers will put their hope in Him

## **Spiritual Vision**

Meditate on John 5:19-20

- For your group and all His workers to see clearly what He is doing
- To be committed to follow Him in that work no matter how great or small it may seem from a human point of view
- That you would not only commit to what He does, but commit to do it in a like manner; pray that He will protect you from the sin of
- doing the right thing the wrong way
- To be drawn into an ever-deepening love relationship with Him, so you are close enough to see what He sees
- That He would work through His children in ways that cause the nations to marvel at Him

#### Lord of the Harvest

#### Meditate on Luke 10:1-2

#### Ask that God will:

- Bring about a true harvest, one that nurtures, sustains and reproduces on an increasingly grander scale
- Begin a movement in your home church to call out laborers to an unreached people group
- Enable leaders in your church to see the direction He is leading them to be in partnership with this people group
- Make clear the involvement you should have in the years to come
- Provide workers with a variety of skills for this partnership
- Confront you personally with His claim on your life until you are at peace with Him

# Worship

Meditate on Jeremiah 29:7, 11-13

# Begin your day:

- Glorifying God for who He is
- Thanking Him for what He's done, is doing and promises to do through this prayer walk
- Praising God for His careful and individual concern for your life
- Letting your heart overflow with the joy of His promises
